Minutes:

- Gail and Russ provided a NEASC progress update
 - Staff was reviewed and voted on Standards 4, 5 at faculty meeting in December (approved)
 - Standard 1 and 3 to be reviewed and voted on 1/25/23 faculty meeting
 - Standard 2 will be reviewed and voted on 2/8/23 faculty meeting
 - Collaborative Conference set for April 5th and 6th
 - Visiting members will tour the school and talk with various stakeholders
 - Once visit concludes, the committee will provide a written report that will support areas of growth
 - Question raised regarding if the committee receives the report ahead of time
 - Committee does receive the report ahead of time
 - Self-reflection report submitted the first week of March
- Review current school improvement plan
 - Teaching and learning goals center on NEASC process
 - School is making effective progress in this goal in preparation for the collaborative conference visit
 - Equitable and Inclusive practices goal reviews data for attendance and discipline
 - Current discipline data was shared with the council so all know what is being shared with staff

- Question asked regarding what constituted away from assigned area
- Largest number in the data source centered on class cuts/missing class
- Perspective of class cuts: 64 instances out of a 6,600 possible opportunities for kids to cut class
- MTSS goal centers on current supports offered and development of BCAP
 - Assembled a committee to develop BCAP (staff)
 - Intend to have BCAP in place next school year
 - Question about what a BCAP is and what it provides
 - Building-based Curriculum Accommodation Plan
 - Kids can get what they need without having to qualify for a IEP/504
 - Does not have to be all the time, can be various times during the year
- Collaborate to Innovate goal centers on developing early college program
 - Not much movement on this (consortium based)
 - Last communication was 12/19/22
 - Dual enrollment with Southeastern has improved in numbers
 - 2022 - 1 student
 - 2023 - 5 students (3 electrical, 2 cosmetology)
- Question to consider moving forward: should dual enrollment be for Jrs as
