

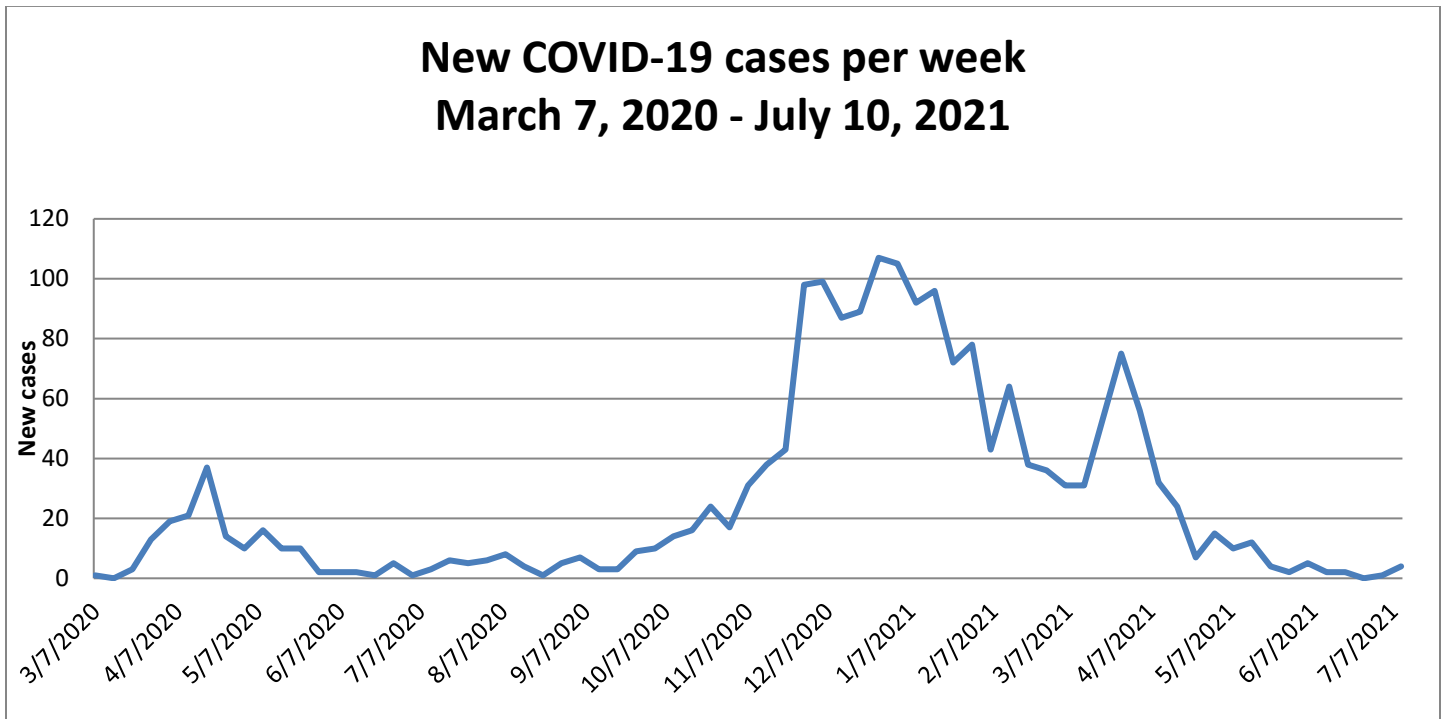
## COMMUNITY UPDATE COVID-19

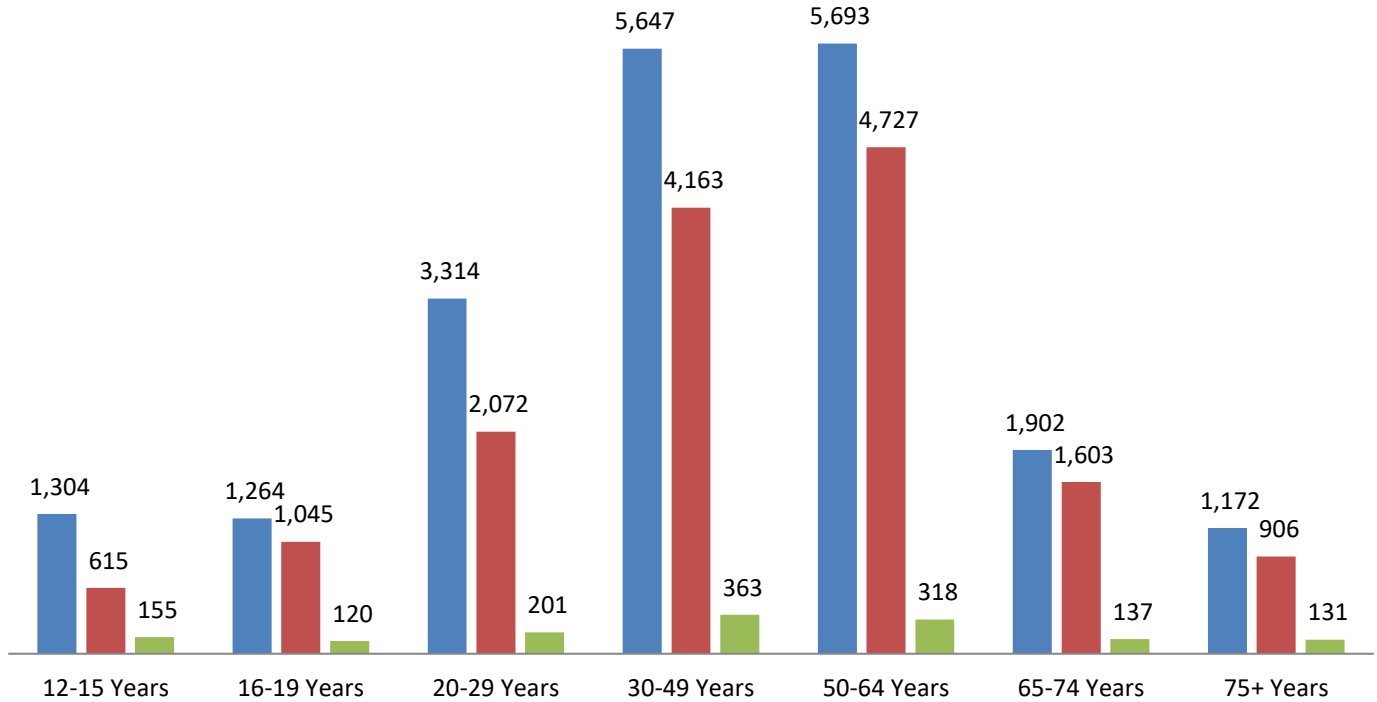

As of July 12, 2021, more than 184.3 million people have received at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine. Of those, more than 159.4 million are fully vaccinated.
